Hi, we hope you are all well and looking forward to the Summer holidays. This month we have done a joint update from both the community council and Cllr Amanda Jenner.

#### Volunteers for footpath improvements

We have recently been discussing a potential Public Access Project with Countryside Services in PCC, around the public rights of way in the area and we are looking for volunteers to help out when the project starts in the Autumn. There are some funds available to do some improvements to public footpaths in our area including potentially looking into a new route being opened up. Recently, when similar work has been done in other areas local to us, community volunteers have assisted the council (with appropriate supervision in place etc). We would like to know if you are interested in volunteering and if so, please do get in touch with us. We also hope to have more information in due course on what the volunteering could involve and so we are just asking for expressions of interest at this stage.

#### Speed limit changes

There will be some changes to the speed on some of our County roads from September. Along Criggion Road, from the trunk road to just past 31 Sevem Wynde will become 20mph and from that point out to just past Garth and Gwelfryn properties, PCC plan to impose a 30mph limit. In Middletown, the road off the trunk road leading to the housing on Golfa Close etc, will become 20mph and the section from just after Pinewood House and Southbank, PCC plan to drop the speed limit to 30mph. The housing on the other side of the A458 towards Mount Pleasant will also become 20mph.

#### **Garden Fires**

Please be considerate when having garden fires. The Council has given some guidance on this for if you are considering having a fire:

- Warn your neighbours lighting a bonfire can cause nuisance to your neighbours especially if it is a nice sunny day with washing out and windows open
- Only burn dry material this is likely to cause less smoke. Never burn household rubbish, rubber tyres or anything containing plastic, foam or paint these can cause harmful emissions
- Never use old engine oil, meths or petrol to light or encourage the fire
- Novid lighting a fire in unsuitable weather conditions smoke hangs in the air on damp days and in the evening. If it is windy smoke may be blown into neighbour gardens and across roads
- Novid burning at weekends and on bank holidays when people want to enjoy their gardens
- Never leave a fire unattended or leave it to smoulder

The code for the machine is on the machine itself. If anyone does have cause to use it, please can you notify either Gill Corfield or Judy Evans afterwards, so they can order new pads for the machine and the defibrillator machine needs to be placed back on the hook after use.


