



### **Transition to Barcoded Postage Stamps**

Royal Mail will be adding unique barcodes to all regular 'everyday' Definitive and Christmas stamps. Definitive stamps feature the profile of HM The Queen. The barcodes match the stamp colour and sit alongside the main body of the stamp, separated by a simulated perforation line. The new barcode is an integral part of the stamp and must remain intact for the stamp to be valid.



Non-barcoded stamps should be used before 31 January 2023. Alternatively, they can be exchanged for the new barcoded version through a 'Swap Out' scheme which opened on 31 March 2022. A 'Swap Out' form can be obtained from the following places: print one off Royal Mail's website; contact Customer Experience and ask them to post one out to you; pick one up from your local Delivery Offices' Customer Service Point. Return to the Freepost address provided together with the stamps you wish to swap. 'Swap out' forms are not available at Post Offices. Non-barcoded Christmas stamps will remain valid as postage after 31 January 2023, so there is no requirement to swap them out.



# Powys County Council

I hope you are all keeping well. I have a few matters to update you on this month: BUTTINGTON INCINERATOR HEARINGS UPDATE

The Planning Inspectorate hearings finished in March and these were attended by representatives from the BIIG Group and I. Unfortunately, they were invite only and not for public attendance. The purpose of the hearings was for the Inspectorate to explore certain areas such as sustainability of the proposals, the need, air quality, traffic impact etc. This was not a decision-making stage of the process. I felt that the hearings were conducted in a professional manner and both the BIIG Group and myself had fair opportunity to make our objecting points and raise issues of concern. I did our upmost to represent the community's concerns, highlight discrepancies in the proposal and fight for the community's interests. The Planning Inspectorate will now work on his report which will be submitted to the Welsh Government Minister by the end of April. It will then be down to the Minister to make the final decision. We don't have a timescale for that. I really hope (& will keep everything crossed) that our efforts are successful. If permission is given, that will not be the end of the matter – the applicant (Broad Energy) will still have to apply for an environmental permit from Natural Resources Wales. That will involve further consultation and consideration of air quality, health impacts and the cloud inversions etc. They would need a permit to operate and so that is still a really important part of the process.

With regard to the new incinerator moratorium announced by the Welsh Government last year, whether or not that actually means anything will now be down for the Welsh Government Minister to decide. I will continue to keep the community posted as I receive any updates.

#### HIGHWAYS

There have been some works done over recent weeks. In particular, the pavement on the corner of Sale lane has been fixed and the drains along Sale lane have been jetted. I am also told that highways have attended some of the other county lanes where there has been some slippage of the road verges and that work orders will be raised for these.

Myself and the community council continue to be concerned that despite our continuous calls for highways to attend to our area, we still have much work that needs doing – some of it urgent now. I am told regularly that the highways people prioritise our patch accordingly against what's needed in the rest of the County and use the resources they have. I have been in discussions with other Councillor colleagues who share my concerns about the resources and the highways teams and have similar problems in their areas. Whilst I cannot go into detail here, I believe this needs to be looked at and changes made.

With regard to the traffic lights on the A458 near Garreg Bank. Residents are concerned that the these have remained for a number of weeks now and work has not been done. I have highlighted to the Trunk Road Manager that traffic is going to increase in the run up to Easter and this needs to be sorted as soon as possible. I have also asked whether traffic lights can be removed whilst waiting for works/surveys of the road, if safe to do so.

#### SCHOOL

As a Governor, I was recently involved in the process of recruiting a new head teacher for Buttington Trewern School. The Governing body are pleased to have appointed Miss Anna Griggs from September when Mr Jenkins takes early retirement. Whilst we are sad to say goodbye to Mr J after so many years of excellent leadership and wish him all the best for the future, we are looking forward to Miss Griggs starting and the ideas and experience she brings.


