

We last met in Jan/Feb 2020 and since that time have lost members due to a variety of reasons plus we were not attracting younger members who would shoulder the responsibility of running the Club. 

MISSED RECYCLING & BIN COLLECTIONS

Unfortunately we continue to experience missed/delayed bin and recycling collections. This has been happening across the County and myself and other Councillors have been highlighting the problems at the most senior levels within the Council. We are told that there have been workforce/recruitment issues as well as sickness within the crews. I continue to raise concerns with the Council and probe into how they are addressing this problem. Any further information I receive I will also post on my Facebook page.

HIGHWAYS

For some time now I have been expressing to the Council that many of our ongoing road maintenance problems are caused by lack of regular drain/gulley clearance. The Community Council and I regularly call on the Council to address this in the ward on a regular basis (rather than just when we see heavy rain and flood risk). However, we are told that there aren't the resources for this. I have previously updated you on the work I have done calling for the Council to try and obtain more drain jetter resource. In the meantime, whilst this is still being considered by the powers that be, I will be submitting a formal public motion to the Full Council (in October) calling for the Highways departments to bring forward drain jetting work and to work with and listen to local councillors and community councils to prioritise high risk areas which if not jetted, can cause localised flooding.


