Royal Mail U-Turn on Non-barcoded Stamps

In the April/May 2022 issue of *Border Gossip* we publicised Royal Mail's announcement that definitive stamps featuring the profile of the late Queen would be invalid for use after 31 January 2023. This deadline has now been extended by six months to 31 July 2023, after which new bar-coded stamps should be used. Special pictorial issues, such as Christmas stamps, will remain valid even if they are not barcoded.

Alternatively, non-barcoded stamps can be exchanged for the new barcoded version through a free 'Swap Out' scheme. A 'Swap Out' form can be printed off from Royal Mail's website and will now be available at Post Offices.

Posting Early for Christmas is even more important!

I hope you are all keeping well as Winter starts to set in. I have a few things to update you on again and as always please do get in touch with me to raise any issues you have relating to the County Council.

Waste Collections

Problems continue with timely and complete pickups of waste recycling, although we have seen some recent improvements in the last few weeks. Many councillors are highlighting frustrations and I continue to raise questions about workforce management and asking what they are doing to try to mitigate this. The latest questions I raised are here:

Bins for Brunant residents on Heldre Lane Cross Roads – I have raised the conditions of these and one is due to be replaced shortly.

Highways

A458 Trunk Road – I passed on that some streetlights were out along the A458 and have been told these are scheduled for repair. I have also chased for an update on when the Cefn bridge safety improvement work will be done.

Trunk Road Crossings – there have been some requests from residents for crossings. Myself and the community council have raised this previously but it wasn't taken forward by the Trunk road. I am now in discussion with the active travel team within PCC who work with Welsh Government and Sustrans (the active travel charity). They have given some initial advice to me on how to take forward what the community/school wants in terms of a scheme which allows children to walk safely from school/bus stops to homes etc and I am progressing their advice.

Drains & Ditches - Following my motion on winter drain clearance which was approved by full council in October, the Community Council and I drove round and identified high risk drain/flood areas. These have all been passed on to the council. I have also had a recent Highways depot meeting where I again highlighted the need to prioritise drain clearance before the winter. Other councillors said the same. I have also formally written to the portfolio holder for highways to ask that work needed following my motion be taken forward. The response to my letter can be read below:

Given the content of that response, I have written again to the Highways department and the highways manager has now said that Heldre Lane and Sale Lane roads will be scheduled; I have pressed that there is already considerable amounts of sitting water across these roads.

Hope Road – I had hoped that this road would be included in the Council's bid for levelling up money. Unfortunately it did not quite make the list. I have however now been told that the highways Supervisor will include the hope road in the capital list for ranking in 2023/24. I am also pleased that there has been some recent pot hole fixes work done here.

Pot Holes – Llyn y Melyn, Heldre Lane, Parc Caradog - these have all been reported again.

Salt Bins/Piles – The Community Council and I have checked a few of these and many are ok. I have put in extra requests for Fox Lane, Moelygolfa, Brunant. Please let me know I you are aware of further supplies needed.

Pentre Gwyn Parking – A number of people have raised concerns about parking obstructions. I have passed this on to the Police who have said they will carry out patrols.

School Willow Tree – many of us have been sad to see the demise of the Willow Tree at Buttington Trewern School, which was planted over 70 years ago by the WI to mark the opening of the school. The headteacher and I have been looking into possible grants for a replacement or for an orchard/sculpture area. I have also asked people to not help themselves to logs and not let children play on there due to safety concerns. It has now been decided that the logs will be sold to raise proceeds for the school. Prior to this, I have suggested to the school that some logs be offered to free to those families on lower incomes who qualify for free school meals.

This is probably my last update for this year. I would like to wish you all a Merry Christmas & Nadolig Llawen. It's been a privilege to be your Councillor for another year – we've had ups and downs in the community and I'll continue doing my best in 2023.


