

## You can now recycle your food and drink cartons from home

Cartons, often referred to as TetraPaks, can now be recycled through your weekly kerbside recycling collections by adding them to your red recycling box. The types of cartons now accepted are drink cartons such as juices, smoothies and milk, and food cartons, such as soup, tomatoes and pulses. Just give



them a quick rinse, squash, then add to your red recycling box. After your recycling has been collected and delivered to the county's waste transfer station, the cartons are separated from the plastics and cans and baled together. As a reminder, in the red boxes Powys CC can now collect:

- Clean and empty plastic bottles, pots, tubs and trays
- Clean and empty tins, cans, kitchen and bathroom aerosols, foil and metal lids
- Clean and empty food and drink cartons

## Welshpool to lose its last high street bank branches

Further to our article in the last issue of *Border Gossip* reviewing bank branch services in Welshpool, the remaining two bank branches are to close. Barclays have announced their intention to close their branch on Friday 16 September at 12.00pm whilst Lloyds Bank will cease trading in Welshpool on 26 January 2023.

On a brighter note, LINK – the UK's Cash Access and ATM network – have carried out a review to assess the effect of bank branch closures on communities and identify where new shared facilities are needed. LINK has recommended that a new Banking Hub be opened in Welshpool.

### What is a Banking Hub?

A Banking Hub aims to create an environment which feels like a friendly, local but secure & private bank branch – but which works for customers of ALL banks.

Last year the Post Office trialed PO BankingHUBs in two pilot locations -Cambuslang (Lanarkshire) and Rochford (Essex). Surveys highlighted issues with local Post Offices in both Cambuslang & Rochford relating to privacy of transactions, safety of the location and time taken to be served.

The banking services found at any Post Office counter were replicated but within separate premises which simply supported cash & banking transactions (no post, parcels etc.). In addition, a private room was created which individual banks were invited to staff for one day per week for a trained banker to meet face-to-face with business & personal customers. The two pilot BankingHUBs were open from 9am-5pm on weekdays and were used extensively by both small business and private customers.

I hope you are enjoying the Summer months. It has been a busy couple of months getting the Council set back up with a new administration and I have quite a few things to update you all on.

#### **BUTTINGTON INCINERATOR DECISION**

On 20th July the Welsh Government announced their decision on the Buttington Incinerator proposal. The Minister has decided that "the application site is not in a sustainable location, fails to comply with the proximity principle ... [and] fails to comply with the Welsh Government's policy for waste management. Finally, due to the identified significant adverse landscape and visual impacts, the application is contrary to LDP Policies DM4 and DM13. I consider these matters outweigh the identified benefits of the proposal. Therefore, I hereby refuse planning permission."

The majority of people who have contacted me about the incinerator have been overwhelmingly concerned about the impact it could have on our local area. I am so grateful that the Welsh Government Minister listened and refused this planning application. The fight against this has been going on for years and I cannot thank enough the members of the Buttington Incinerator Impact Group for all their hard work campaigning against this. Also, thanks to the Community Council and all the local residents who responded to the consultation and have continuously made their concerns about the proposal known. Our local elected politicians have also listened to the community and joined the campaign against this too. Russell George MS and his colleagues in the Senedd called for a moratorium on new large-scale incinerators a number of years ago and Craig Williams MP also raised the concerns about this proposal in Westminster. Thank you so much to them for supporting us and for listening, I really am incredibly grateful.

There is a possibility of appeal against this decision by way of Judicial Review. My understanding is that should the applicant decide to do this then they would have to do so quickly as there are strict timeframes. If I receive any news of this, I will update everyone accordingly.

#### MISSED RECYCLING & BIN COLLECTIONS

Over the last few months we have seen a number of missed/delayed bin and recycling collections. This has been happening across the County and myself and other Councillors have been highlighting the problems at the most senior levels within the Council. We are told that there have been workforce/recruitment issues as well as sickness within the crews. A number of people have contacted me directly when their bin(s) have been missed and I then follow this up with the relevant team member. You can also report your missed bins on this link:

#### **HIGHWAYS**

A458 – Cefn Bridge area – Welsh Government have commissioned safety improvements (surfacing, signage and slight speed limit changes) for the Bridge. My understanding is that design for this is in its final stages and works will be done soon. I have highlighted that road markings have faded and works need to be done ASAP.

A few weeks ago, myself and the Community council updated the Council's online reporting system to ensure that all our previously reported issues are now on their online system. We are told that these issues will be addressed according to priority. I remain concerned that the time it takes to address particularly bad potholes, is too slow. I will continue to work with Council colleagues highlighting our concerns. You can also report any issues you come across directly:

Drain Jetters - many of our ongoing problems are caused by lack of regular drain/gulley clearance. The Community Council and I regularly call on the Council to address this in the ward on a regular basis (rather than just when we see heavy rain and flood risk). However, we are told that there aren't the resources for this. I recently saw an opportunity for the Council to try and obtain more drain jetter resource and called on the Council to do this. #### MY ROLE IN THE COUNCIL

Now that the new Council administration has been formed, Councillors have all been allocated committees and other roles. I am pleased to let you know that I will be on the following committees:

- Health & Social Care Committee I Chair this Powys wide committee which reviews and scrutinises health and social care policy in Powys

#### **Update from Trewern Community Council**

Hi All, Hope you are keeping well and managed to stay cool during the heatwave?!

As you are already aware, we have been eagerly awaiting a decision on the Buttington Incinerator planning application from the Welsh Government Minister. The Planning Inspectorate recommended that this application be refused, in which the Minister has also agreed. The refusal was based on the following main issues:

- Whether the proposal would be consistent with the aims of waste planning policy in Wales
  in terms of need, sustainability and direction of travel, in the context of national and
  development plan policy;
- The effect of the proposal on air quality and human health;
- The landscape and visual impact effects of the proposal on the character of the area and on receptors;
- The effect of the operation of the proposal on nature conservation, biodiversity and the
  ecology of the area. In particular, whether there would be significant effects on the
  Montgomery Canal Special Area of Conservation and SSSI, and Moel y Golfa SSSI;
- The effects of the development on highway safety; and
- Whether the benefits of the proposal outweigh any adverse impacts that are identified.

(If you would like a copy of the report and the full reasons of why the application has been refused, please get in touch with us and we can forward this onto you).

We know that the majority of the Community were opposed to this development and so we would like to say a huge thank you to Cllr. Amanda Jenner and the BIIG (Buttington Incinerator Impact Group) for all your hard work in campaigning against this application.

We will not be meeting in August, so our next Community Council meeting will now be held in September. If anyone would like to join this meeting, please let us know and you can either attend in person or we can supply you with the link for you to join online.

Again, we are continuing to raise any Highways problems, such as drainage and pot hole issues with Powys monthly. If you would like to highlight any concerns to us or if you have any other Community Council issues you would like to raise, please get in touch with us.


