Buttington Trewern School Sponsored Read with Usborne Books

Recently pupils at Buttington Trewern CP School smashed their latest sponsored read event!

After being inspired by World Book Day the pupils took part in a sponsored read event. They recorded how long they read each day over a period of a week and collected sponsor money off family and friends.



Kim, from BookBarn (Independent Usborne Partner) said 'The pupils loved taking part and parents were so supportive. I didn't have the heart to only give some children a prize so they each got a little doodle book, bookmark and chocolate lolly.'

The pupils raised a fantastic amount, around £600, with Usborne adding on 60% in free books. As a result Kim was able to order over £900 in brand new books for the school.

Using the Usborne catalogue the school identified which books would best support 'A Curriculum for Wales' and some of the topics that the school follows. There was a big focus on purchasing books to support languages and also well being too. The children have already been using them during independent research and also French sessions.

I hope you are all well and enjoying the start of the Summer months. Here are some matters to report back to you:

- The drains up towards Mount Pleasant in Middletown have finally been done.
- Residents have reported some issues with bin collections with the bins not being put back properly or broken. Please let me know if this happens to you.
- I have had a few obstructive parking issues raised with me which I have raised with Powys Housing and the Police. If you live and park amongst other residents please do not park in a way that causes an obstruction. For example one parked car has caused issues with bin collection vehicles accessing residents in Middletown and others have caused obstructions in Pentre Gwyn.
- Just a reminder about the types of issues you can raise with me, please note that I can take up any matters to do with the council. For example. I have recently been contacted by a resident with Powys housing concerns and another about a school transport application. If I am unable to help you because your issue is outside of my remit, e.g. it concerns a Welsh Government or UK Government matter, or a legal matter, I will endeavour to help signpost you to someone else that can help.
- Finally just to let you know that in terms of my wider council role, I have been re-appointed as the Chair of Powys' Health and Social Care Scrutiny Committee.

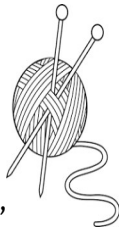

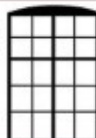
