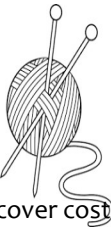

iPads now available to borrow from Powys Libraries



Want to get online but without the expense of buying your own equipment? Members of the Powys Library service aged 18+ can now borrow an iPad for free from their local library. Anyone who lives, works or is studying in Powys can join the library for free. The 'internet ready' iPads are available to borrow for four weeks at a time.

Each iPad holds a SIM card with a mobile data allowance for anyone without a home Wi-Fi connection. Devices must be booked in advance.

For anyone who hasn't used an iPad or mobile device before, librarians are on hand to get you started and are available by phone or in person throughout your loan. On return all data will be wiped from the iPad for security purposes.

To find out more, or to request an iPad, please contact Welshpool library in person, call the Library Line on 01874 612394 or email library@powys.gov.uk.

Lack of digital access can lead to isolation and can be a barrier to accessing council services and information. The iPads are part of the Digital Powys project with support from the Welsh Government Circular Economy Fund. It is also part of the council's Transformation Programme to deliver aspirations of the Vision 2025 corporate improvement plan.

I'm so grateful to have been re-elected to represent the Trewern and Trelystan Ward as your County Councillor for the next 5 years. Thank you to everyone who supported me, it really does mean a lot.

I will continue to fight for our area and for your voices to be heard. Please do continue to get in touch with me if you have any council issues to raise.

I do not yet know what Council Committees I will be sitting on as this is still to be finalised (as I write this). I hope to continue to be able to be involved with Social Services and scrutinise policy impacting our most vulnerable residents.

With regard to local issues, I have the following updates:

Buttington Incinerator

We are still awaiting a decision from the Welsh Government Minister and I will provide an update as soon as I have any further information. I am anticipated a decision between now and August.

Highways

There are a number of ongoing highways issues which are not being resolved quickly. I have a meeting with senior council officers at the end of May and will continue to raise our concerns. I will also be making the case for an improved communication system between the council and County Councillors regarding ongoing highways maintenance concerns.

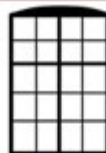
