



#### Local Residents targeted by Scammers

#### Dyfed-Powys Police wish to warn residents of scams currently prevalent in the area.



Texts and emails are being sent to lure people to apply for the Covid-19 vaccine.

DC Gareth Jordan, from the Cyber Crime Unit, said: The text is made to look like it comes from the NHS and states 'we have identified that you

are eligible to apply for your vaccine' and advises you to follow a link to get more information and 'apply'. If you follow the link, you are taken to a convincing looking, but fake NHS website that asks for your personal details. After entering your details, it then requests bank/card details to check your identity. Also, **beware of cold calls and emails regarding the vaccine as scammers are also asking people to pay for it over the phone.** Remember – the vaccine is free of charge and there is no way to jump the queue by paying for a "priority slot".

#### Be on your guard against an Amazon scam.

Residents are being called, sometimes by an automated message, with scammers pretending to be from the online retailing giant to say that £79.97 is owed on their Amazon account– but if they don't want to pay, they can cancel Amazon by pressing '1'.

There may also be a call that states there has been unauthorised spending on the account (often over £1,000), and again, the request is to press '1' to go through to the 'Fraud Department'.

A police spokesperson says if 1 is pressed, then the scammers will attempt to get as many personal details as possible from the victim, and then try to gain access to their bank details. For any of these types of call, it is best to hang up immediately. If you don't have an Amazon account you will know the call is fake. Otherwise, check your account online by using the app on your phone, or by typing in the correct url such as www.amazon.uk and log into your account that way to check.

#### Police advice:

- If you receive one of these phone calls, hang up and block the number.
- Confirm requests are genuine by using a known number or email address to contact organisations directly.
- Do not click on links or attachments in unexpected or suspicious texts or emails.
- If you have received an email, which you are not quite sure about, forward it to the Suspicious Email Reporting Service (SERS) at report@phishing.gov.uk.
- Suspicious text messages should be forwarded to 7726. This freeof-charge code enables your provider to investigate the origin of the text and take action, if found to be malicious. An easy way to remember 7726 is that they are the numbers on your telephone keypad that spell out the word SPAM.
- The NHS, the police, or your bank, will never ask you to withdraw money or transfer it to a different account. They will also never ask you to reveal your full banking password or PIN.
- Contact your bank immediately if you think you've fallen victim to a scam and report it to the Police.

#### A Chill Wind Blowing through Welshpool?

A chill wind is blowing down the high street, as shopping & banking practices change. Changes which have been accelerated by the pandemic.

W H Smith closes on 27 February, Oliver's in Spring due to retirement, Janeeva in Summer and now HSBC have announced that the last day of



trading at their Welshpool branch will be 24 September.

These closure will leave large gaps in the Town Centre which may be difficult to fill in the current economic climate.. Premises vacated by NatWest bank in September 2017 remain unoccupied.



#### Police are asking us to review our security measures after eight thefts were reported over the past month along the Montgomeryshire border with West Mercia.

Power tools and farm equipment have been targeted as thieves step up their activity in the area, with police asking for our help to report suspicious

activity. Inspector Matthew Price said: Local officers will be targeting suspicious activity along the borders and I would also ask that any suspicious people/activities are reported to the police.

I would encourage residents to ensure that their property is secure and valuables are protectively marked and locked away.+

There isn't a big problem with burglary in our area. However, a lapse of security in general can allow burglars to enter your home or your outbuildings. Taking some simple precautions to protect yourself and your property against crime can not only make you feel safer, it can also reduce your chances of becoming a victim of crime:

- Fit strong locks to your doors and windows and make sure you always keep them fully locked;
- Try to make your home look occupied if you are away from your property overnight. Invest in a plug-in timer for lamps and radios;
- Consider installing a burglar alarm. A burglar alarm fitted properly can deter a burglar and the sight of an alarm box outside your home may be enough to discourage them;
- Prevent intruders getting to the back and sides of your home by installing strong fencing or gates;
- Never leave a spare key in a convenient hiding place such as under the doormat, in a flowerpot or behind a loose brick thieves know to look there first;
- Use movement sensitive lights externally;
- If you are replacing or fitting new doors and windows, get ones that are certified to British Standard BS7950 (windows) and PAS 24-1 (doors);
- Fit a door chain or bar and door viewer (spy-hole) and use them every time someone calls;
- Ensure good quality locks are fitted to your shed and are securely locked. Windows should be fitted with locks.

# Census 2021 will provide a snapshot of modern society

Households across Powys will soon be asked to take part in Census 2021.

The census is a once-in-a-decade survey that gives us the most accurate estimate of all the people and households in England and Wales.

# **Census** 2021

It has been carried out every decade since 1801, with the exception of 1941.

It will be the first run predominantly online, with households receiving a letter with a unique access code, allowing them to complete the questionnaire on their computers, phones or tablets.

"A successful census will ensure everyone from local government to charities can put services and funding in the places where they are most needed," Iain Bell, deputy national statistician at the Office for National Statistics, said.


"This could mean things like doctors' surgeries, schools and new transport routes. That's why it is so important everyone takes part and we have made it easier for people to do so online on any device, with help and paper questionnaires for those that need them."

Census day will be on March 21, but households across the country will receive letters with online codes allowing them to take part from early March.

In Wales, households will also be asked a specific question about their Welsh language skills. And those who wish to complete the census in Welsh can do so both online and in paper form. There are "Cymraeg" and "English" buttons to switch between languages at any time online, and on paper you can use Welsh and English on the same form.

Results will be available within 12 months, although personal records will be locked away for 100 years, kept safe for future generations.

#### Level 4 Restrictions mean that everyone must:

- · Stay 2 metres from anyone you do not live with
- Not travel without reasonable excuse.

**REMEMBER** 'exercise should <u>start and finish from your home and generally</u>, this <u>should not involve people driving to a location away from home</u>. Where people need to drive to access exercise, the journey should be to the nearest convenient accessible location. No long journeys should be undertaken unless absolutely necessary. The need to carry sports equipment is not regarded as a justification on its own for driving in these circumstances. <u>Leaving your</u> <u>home to exercise should not be used as an excuse to undertake other activity</u> <u>which is not permitted.</u> The purpose of leaving home is to exercise. Going for a walk and then having a picnic or spending a prolonged period on a park bench, for example, is not considered to be exercise.'
